## What is the NCIT Specialized program?

While the NCIT Basic program provides a core curriculum for certification, the NCIT Specialized program offers advanced certification in individual subject areas including interviewing techniques, investigative analysis and report development. The three-day program is designed to promote interaction through use of small groups, role-playing exercises and case studies.

## Who should attend?

Anyone who has successfully completed the NCIT Basic program is eligible to attend. Registrants must include location and dates of NCIT Basic training in order to register.

## What is covered in the NCIT Specialized program curriculum?

The NCIT Specialized program provides an opportunity to spend a full day working through each of three program modules:

- Advanced Interviewing Techniques—including cognitive memory recall and behavioral analysis interviewing
- Advanced Investigative Analysis—including complaint scene analysis and written statement analysis
- Investigative Report Development—including observations skills and writing factual reports

## Can I receive certification for this course?

Anyone who achieves a minimum score of 70% on each of the course examinations is eligible for CLEAR Specialized certification.

## How do I register?
